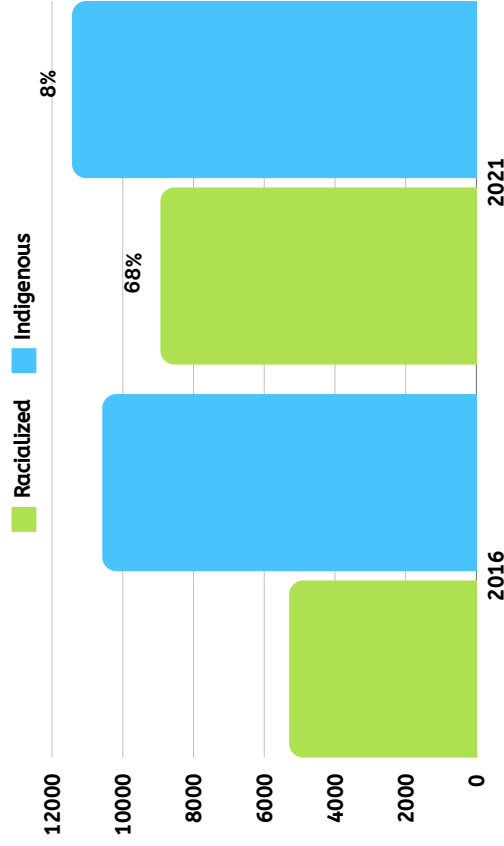
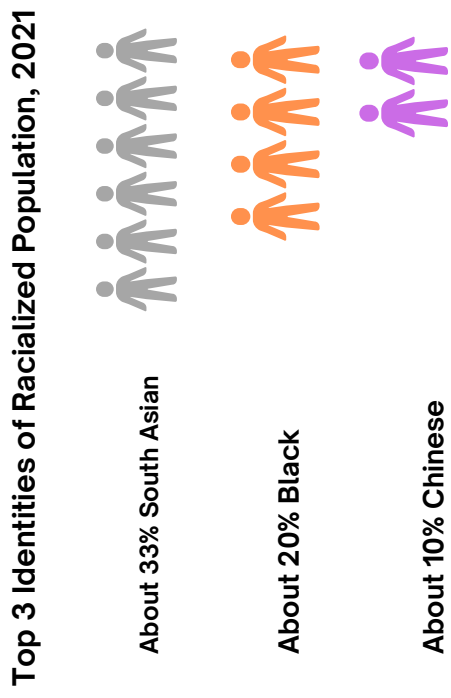
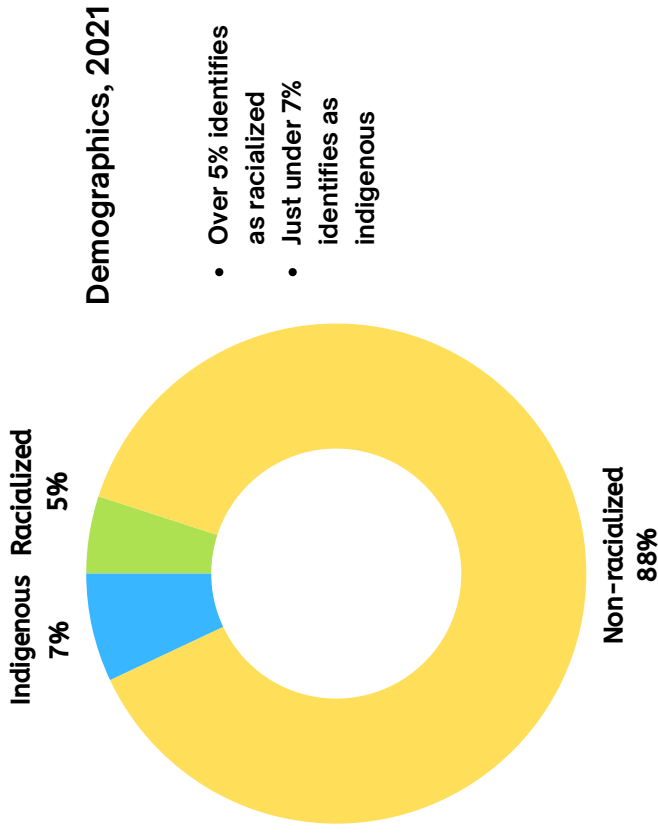

# Racialized and Indigenous Populations in HPEC (2021 Census)



- The racialized population has grown by over 68%
- The Indigenous population has increased by 8%
- The Indigenous population in Canada is growing at twice the rate of non-Indigenous Canadians.
